Do you keep your dog chained in your backyard? Would you like to unchain your dog but don't have a fence to keep them safe? Would you like to gain knowledge in training so you could bring your dog inside your home? The Marion County Animal Control Ordinance dealing with tethering dogs has been changed and is stricter than ever.

WE CAN HELP

The **Pet Parenting Program** will teach you how to bring your dog inside and will teach your dog how to live inside with you. Dogs are pack animals. They want to be with their human pack. Attend the class and we will provide:

- up to \$200 in fencing materials if needed,
- assistance installing a fence in your yard,
- in-home training, if necessary,
- *free* spay/neuter services, immunizations and microchipping in exchange for volunteer service,
- humane education for your children.

Registration is required. Two-part classes will be held on the first and second Saturday of every month at the Humane Society of Marion County from 10 a.m. to 12 noon, 701 NW 14th Rd., Ocala.
